

Privacy Policy

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This Privacy Policy describes how CoatiPress (“Company,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) collects, uses, and shares information when you visit or interact with <https://coatipress.com/> (the “Website”).

By using this Website, you agree to the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Who We Are

2. Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information depending on how the Website is used.

Information You Provide

You may voluntarily provide personal information such as:

- Name
- Email address
- Username
- Profile information
- Messages or comments
- Uploaded media
- Other information you submit through forms or accounts

Automatically Collected Information

When you visit the Website, certain information may be collected automatically, including:

- IP address
- Browser type
- Device type

- Operating system
- Pages visited
- Time and date of visit
- Referring websites
- Cookies and tracking identifiers

This information may be collected using cookies, server logs, analytics tools, or similar technologies.

3. Comments

When visitors leave comments on the site we collect the data shown in the comments form, and also the visitor's IP address and browser user agent string to help spam detection.

An anonymized string created from your email address (also called a **hash**) may be provided to the **Gravatar service** to see if you are using it.

After approval of your comment, your profile picture may be visible publicly in the context of your comment.

4. Media Uploads

If you upload images to the Website, you should avoid uploading images with embedded location data (EXIF GPS) included.

Visitors to the Website may be able to download and extract location data from images available on the site.

5. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We may use cookies and similar technologies to improve user experience, analyze traffic, and support site functionality.

Comment Cookies

If you leave a comment on our site you may opt-in to saving your name, email address, and website in cookies. These cookies are for your convenience so you do not have to re-enter your details when leaving another comment.

These cookies typically last for **one year**.

Login Cookies

If you visit our login page, we may set a temporary cookie to determine if your browser accepts cookies. This cookie contains no personal data and is deleted when you close your browser.

When you log in we may set cookies to save:

- Login information
- Screen display preferences

Login cookies generally last **two days** unless “Remember Me” is selected, which may extend the session.

Editing Cookies

If you edit or publish an article, an additional cookie may be saved in your browser indicating the post ID of the article edited. This cookie expires after **1 day**.

Other Cookies

Depending on the Website configuration, cookies may also be used for:

- Analytics
- Advertising
- Affiliate tracking
- Security
- Performance optimization

You may disable cookies in your browser settings, although some site features may not function properly.

6. Analytics, Advertising, and Tracking

The Website **may use analytics or advertising services** such as:

- Google Analytics
- Advertising networks
- Affiliate tracking systems
- Third-party analytics tools

These services may collect information such as:

- Device identifiers
- Browsing behavior
- IP addresses
- Interaction with website content

This data helps us understand website usage and improve services.

Third-party providers may have their own privacy policies governing their data collection practices.

7. Embedded Content from Other Websites

Articles or pages on this Website may include embedded content (such as videos, images, or articles).

Embedded content behaves in the same way as if you visited the other website directly.

These third-party websites may:

- Collect data about you
- Use cookies
- Implement additional tracking
- Monitor interactions with embedded content

This may occur especially if you are logged into the third-party service.

8. How We Use Your Information

We may use collected information to:

- Provide and maintain the Website
- Improve functionality and user experience
- Respond to comments or inquiries
- Prevent spam and abuse
- Monitor security and prevent fraud
- Provide advertising or marketing
- Analyze traffic and site performance
- Comply with legal obligations

9. Sharing of Information

We may share information in the following circumstances:

Service Providers

Information may be shared with third-party providers that assist with:

- Website hosting
- Analytics
- Advertising
- Email delivery
- Spam detection
- Security services

Legal Requirements

We may disclose information if required to:

- Comply with legal obligations
- Enforce our policies
- Protect rights, property, or safety
- Respond to lawful requests from authorities

Business Transfers

Information may be transferred in connection with:

- Mergers
- Acquisitions
- Asset sales
- Corporate restructuring

Sale or Sharing of Data

Depending on how the Website operates, personal information **may or may not be sold, shared, or used for targeted advertising** as defined under certain privacy laws.

Users may have the right to opt out where applicable.

10. Password Resets

If you request a password reset, your **IP address may be included in the reset email** for security purposes.

11. Data Retention

We retain personal information only as long as necessary for the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy.

Examples:

- Comments and their metadata may be retained indefinitely to recognize follow-up comments.
 - Registered users may have profile data stored while their account exists.
 - Certain data may be retained longer for security, legal, or administrative purposes.
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12. User Accounts

For users who register on our Website (if any):

We store personal information provided in the user profile.

Users may generally:

- View their personal information
- Edit their personal information
- Request deletion of their data

Username may not always be changeable.

Website administrators may also view and edit user information as necessary.

13. Your Privacy Rights

Depending on your location, you may have certain rights regarding your personal data.

These may include the right to:

- Access personal data we hold about you
- Request correction of inaccurate information
- Request deletion of personal data
- Request restriction of processing
- Request portability of your data

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- Opt out of targeted advertising or sale of data

18. Children's Privacy

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13.

If we learn that such data has been collected, we will take steps to delete it.

19. Where Your Data Is Sent

Visitor comments may be checked through **automated spam detection services**.

Data may also be processed by third-party providers that support website operations.

We may update this Privacy Policy periodically.

Continued use of the Website after changes indicates acceptance of the updated policy.
